Learning Overview

Language, Literacy and Communication

Literacy

- Join in with Nursery Rhymes and learn simple actions.
- Follow picture books and texts read to them and respond appropriately.
- Talk about what might happen next.
- Hold books the correct way and turn pages.
- Read traditional stories together, such as: Goldilocks, Jack and the Beanstalk and The Three Little Pigs

Welsh:

- Joining in Welsh action songs
- Listen to stories and respond appropriately
- Colour sorting in Welsh - Coch, Oren, Meyln, Glas.

Mathematical Development

- Recite numbers up to 10 and beyond, forwards and backwards, using songs and rhymes.
- Ordering numbers to 10 and beyond.
- Shape matching and making patterns
- Adding one more
- Taking away, one less within 10

Health and Wellbeing

- Story Books linked to emotions and feelings
- Relationships and Friendships
- sharing and taking turns
- Recognising 'what is important to me'
- Thinking about being kind and showing respect - linking to our school values.

Complete these activities frequently:

The activities below are to be completed over the course of the term:

<p>Go exploring! Go for a walk or into an outdoor space, the garden or local park. What buildings can you see?</p> <p>Build the Pigs' Houses Use straw, sticks, and small bricks to make your own pig houses. Then, pretend to be the Big Bad Wolf and try to "blow" them down!</p>	<p>See Purple Mash 2Do</p>  <p>Huff and Puff Science Experiment Test how much "huff and puff" it takes to blow different objects over, like feathers, straws, and small blocks.</p>	<p>Nature Hunt Search for materials that match the pigs' houses, find straw-like grass, sticks, and stones. Can you use these to help make your houses?</p> <p>Draw a picture Can you draw a picture of your home or a favourite place you like to visit? You could use pencils, chalk outside, paints, anything you like. Remember to Send some photos on Dojo!</p>	<p>Building Can you make your own building? Using blocks or junk modelling, you could make your house, our school?</p> <p>Crafts Use paint, junk modelling, crayons, playdough or anything else you have at home. Mix colours and see what colours you can make, do some handprint and finger painting, print some patterns. Be creative!</p>
